
Led by Rev. Steven Peiffer, Pastor, Wallingford United United Methodist Church (and friend and colleague of Pastor Kim)

Our fall Bible study this year will be a six week study, beginning Thursday, September 14 and continuing through Thursday, October 19.






BOOKS FOR THE PUMPKIN FESTIVAL
